- We have performed 769 Surgeries during this month. However, due to heavy and continuous raining throughout the month, the overall output was somewhat less. Still it is more than the August month last year.

This year, we are conducting night health education sessions in different villages daily and carried out rallies of school children in Mandvi and Umarkhadi villages. ## TRUCK DRIVERS' SCREENING PROJECT

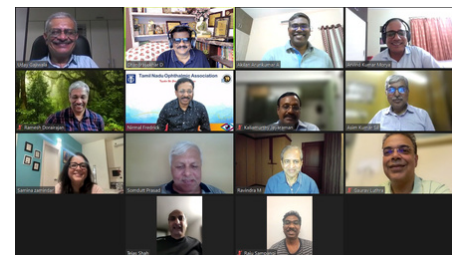
