SCHOOL SCREENING



- We are working with two teams to increase the coverage. We have started going back to the school children who were provided spectacles to find out the compliance of spectacles.

VISION CENTRES

- New field workers have been recruited in the Netrang, Vyara and Bardoli blocks. Their training was done during the month and they have started doing field work.
- We have started bi monthly visit of a team consisting of Ophthalmologist, Ophthalmic assistant, maintenance staff and cleaning staff to vision centres as per the suggestion of Aravind team during LEAP series. This will strengthen the quality of the work done at vision centres.



ROP PROJECT

- We have screened 117 babies and treated 1 baby during the month. One session of parents' education was conducted during the month at Navsari and Rajpipla civil hospital. Almost 40 -50 parents and staff were present at the education session.

- We have found 3 new blind students through our school screening activity. With that there are 13 blind students in our hostel. Mandvi college students donated blankets to our blind children. There are many individuals from Mandvi who bring in food for our blind students as a part of birthday / anniversary celebration.
