## Hospital



- We have performed 1442 Surgeries during this month, less than the last month performance. The hospital remained busy throughout the month inspite of Holi and Dhuleti festivals.
- However, with temperature going up, patients have already started telling us that they will get operated in winter. Over all, the performance has gone up by about 4% compared to last year. This year, we have performed more than 13800 surgeries - the highest ever number in 13 years. We are happy for the opportunity granted by the Alimghy.
- We have procured endo nasal DCR equipment. It will be installed soon and then the DCR surgery will become much less traumatic to the patient. Thanks to the initiative of our visting Oculoplasty consultant Dr. Shalin Shah for the same.
- Dr. Himarshi Mehta our cornea fellow received Gold medal at the convocation function organised at Ahmedabad. Many congratulations to her and best wished for the future.
- Dr. Miti Shah has completed her one and a half years' comprehensive fellowship by the end of this month and left us.
- A 7 years old girl from a very far off place - more than 150 kms away was brought to the hospital after 15 days of trauma to her eye with wood. The wooden stick was removed elsewhere but the family was advised to come to Tejas hospital. Due to lack of money, they came late. We performed four different surgical procedures - corneal tear repair, intra vitreal injection of antibiotics, pars plana vitrectomy and SF IOL implantation. At the end of this, we could restore her vision to 6/18. We are grateful to the Almighty Lord for making this possible. Our efforts have paid off and we are happy.

Diagnostic eye camps: remaining

- KAPS authority have sponsored 500 cataract operations this year. The MOU was signed in February. Our team has managed well to perform more than 430 surgeries by the end of March.
- Eye camps and spectacles distribution camps in Songadh taluka are going on well. We have organised more than 90 camps - one camp in each village (extra effort to reach each individual in need) by now. More than 2150 readymade spectacles and 218 tailormade spectacles are distributed during the month. Our special thanks to Shrimad Rajchandra Hospital, Dharampur and Shri Manubhai Shah from USA for the same.

CONFERENCE AND WORKSHOP

- Dr. Kavin attended DOS conference towards the end of the month. He talked about a trauma patient 7 years old girl whose vision could be saved after 4 surgical procedures. Details mentioned in hospital section.
- Dr. Uday, Dr. Uma and Dr. Kavin attended the All India Ophthalmology Conference at Kolkata during the month. Dr. Uday delivered two talks, Dr. Uma had four poster presentations and Dr. Kavin had three poster presentations.

CBR PROJECT FOR SONGADH TALUKA

- During this month, we have screened 2365 individuals and covered a population of 27383 cataract operations have been performed on patients from Songadh block during the month. All 16 workers are working hard to complete the survey work quickly. We carried out an intensive field work to identify incurable blinds among the surveyed population during the month. We found total 50 incurably blinds. Two community meetings - one in Songadh and the other in Patharada village were organised during the month. The attendance was good at both places and community is very supportive & appreciative of our efforts. M/S Sajjan India has sponsored this project under their CSR activity. They are happy with the outcome at the end of the year.

- There are 13 blind students in our hostel. Children have settled well. Teaching them braille, computer and music is going on as usual. Children participated in the khel mahakumbh organised in Vyara and won prizes worth Rs. 50000/-.

TRUCK DRIVERS' SCREENING PROJECT

- Toll booth people joined hands in organising 3 camps for screening of truck drivers. We are happy with this positive development.

ROP PROJECT

- We have screened 125 babies and treated 1 babies during the month. We could complete the targets for Navsari district as per the MOU with Mission for Vision.



**GENERAL**

- Due to Holi and Dhuleti, the civil work came to a stop in the middle of the month. It has restarted towards the end of the month. All different finishing tasks are also being taken up simultaneously now. A final decision on date of inauguration will be taken in the board meeting on 14th April.
- Finishing of ground floor of C block including flooring, colour work, electric wiring, plumbing and fitting of windows etc. is completed by the end of the month.
- Eyecreel 600 IOL study of Biotech was started during the month. Total ... enrolements has already been done including .. patients bilateral enrolement.
- We have received our renewed HOTA registration and Eye bank license for five years during the month.
- Our GPCB registration renewal has also happened after the inspection done by office from the department on 15.3.24.
- Mr. Praveen Joshi and Mr. Deshraj Bansal visited our hospital and discussed the progress of three projects supported by them.
- Mr. Yash Lala - station director unit 3, Dr. Vankhede - Superintendant of KAPS clinic and Mr. Kevat - CSR head from KAPS visited the hospital on 19th to meet patients who are undergoing surgeries sponsored by them.
