NETRAJYOTI TRAINING CENTER

- Training of two batches of Vision Assistant students is going on well. Theory is almost completed. They are picking up practical skills nicely. They will complete their one year training by the end of October.
- The new batch of Vision Assistant students was started from 1st August – for the first time, there are 33 students and there is no drop out to our surprise after two months. All the students seem to be sincere and working hard to pick up the theory. We feel happy about this development. In fact, we had to say no to five students who wanted to join this batch.
- Fourth batch of Optometry students had started their internship from August. All of them are getting stipend. Admissions for the new batch are going on. Third round will take place in next month. The college will start after Diwali most probably.
- Dr. Kalyani Narote did her phaco fellowship during the month.
- Dr. Uday, Mr. Nikhil and Mr. Yatin attended cross learning meeting to understand vision centre functioning of 2 days at BPA, Ahmedabad organised by SEVA foundation.

VISION CENTRES

- We have continued bi monthly visit of a team consisting of Ophthalmologist, Ophthalmic assistant, maintenance staff and cleaning staff to vision centres.
- Overall, the performance of all the vision centres has improved. Particularly where field work is happening in the afternoon, the OPD seems to be picking up.

ROP PROJECT

- We have screened 124 babies and treated 8 babies during the month.

TRUCK DRIVERS' SCREENING PROJECT

- 3 camps were conducted during the month. By now, we have screened close to 1952 truck drivers and cleaners in 25 camps.

- There are 13 blind students in our hostel. Children have settled well. Teaching them braille, computer and music is going on as usual.

GENERAL

- We have completed enrolment of forty patients in the dry eye study of Alcon by the early September. A site monitoring visit was carried out during the month by the CRO.
- We have distributed 21 artificial intelligence enabled devices called “SMARTON” to blind individuals. This will enable blinds to identify currency notes, read and identify objects / humans in front of them. A small sensor based device is developed indigenously by our maintenance department which will buzz when there will be an obstacle 2 ft ahead of the person.
- One pair of dresses was distributed to 180 kids of Naren Ashramshala.
- Raining has stopped. Internal and external plaster of B building will be completed in first week of October. Electrical work is also going on in three buildings. Internal masonry work and plaster work is going on. We have procured plumbing material. Granite application at seal level has started in B building. We hope to finish civil work in C building and D building by the end of November.
