#### **HOSPITAL**

- We have performed 825 Surgeries during this month. However, due to heavy and continuous raining throughout the month, the overall output was somewhat less. Still it is more than the July month last year.
- An epidemic of adenoviral conjunctivitis hit us in the later half of July. It has occurred almost at PAN India level. We created a separate OPD for these patients and suggested to the patients to avoid undergoing surgery if there was a conjunctivitis patient in the family. We reduced surgical work also. Luckily, in our area, the disease is mild and patients generally recovered within 2-3 days.
- Dr. Vidhi Patel has completed her one and a half years long Comprehensive Ophthalmology fellowship by the end of the month. She has done very good work. We wish her all the success in her future endeavours.
- Dr. Akruti Jariwala joined us as a consultant from 1st July. She will be with us for two years.

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#### **GENERAL**

- Equivalency determination (we are equivalent to USA charitable organisation) for Tarsadia Foundation is under process. Should be completed soon.
- We have been able to enrol thirty two patients in the dry eye study of Alcon by the end of July. A site monitoring visit was carried out during the month by the CRO. Enrolment in Toric IOL study of Omni ltd. is going on 12 more patients need to be enrolled.
- Our IT department staff has developed an indigenous data entry application for the field workers to enter data at the site from villages. They will be able to enter data offline also if internet connection is not available. The data will come to the server at Mandvi. This will make their work paperless and for us, tracking and reporting of their data will become easy.
- Our trustee Shri Ramnarayanji Chandak distributed one pair of dress, school bag, compass box, notebooks and one spiritual book to more than 600 children of four ashramshalas around with the help of Manas mandal, Mahila Mandal, Chhanyado and Helping hands organisation, Surat. 
