## NETRAJYOTI TRAINING CENTRE

- Internship of Vision assistant students is going on nicely. We are paying them a stipend during internship. There are three other batches in training at present.
- New batch of optometry students have also joined from this month. There are 15 students in this 6th batch.

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- Internship of third batch of optometry students is also going on well. In fact, one of the students posted in Mumbai is getting Rs. 15,000/- as monthly stipend. We are happy that our students are able to perform wherever we place them.
- Dr. Trupti Bhesaniya from Surat completed her one month Phaco fellowship during this month. Dr. Nikhil Thadani from Ankleshwar has joined his two months SICS fellowship during the month.

## SCHOOL SCREENING

• We are working with two teams to increase the coverage. We have screened more than 16000 students in this year. We have started going back to the school children who were provided spectacles to find out the compliance of spectacles. However, now year-end final exams are approaching and so we have stopped school screening activity from the end of this month. Now, this activity will restart from June after schools reopen.

## **VISION CENTRES**

- New field workers have started field work in Netrang, Vyara and Bardoli blocks.
- We have continued bi monthly visit of a team consisting of Ophthalmologist, Ophthalmic assistant, maintenance staff and cleaning staff to vision centres.
- Overall, the performance of all the vision centres has improved. We will soon have two staff members at each vision centre and one of the two persons will do field work in the afternoons. We will start conducting small camps with the help of the vision centre staff on a weekly / fortnightly basis around vision centre.

#### We have screened 167 babies and treated 6 babies during the month. One session of parents' education was conducted during the month Vyara Almost 58 parents and staff were present at the education session.

#### **ROP PROJECT**



 Our ROP project with Mission for Vision has come to an end with the end of the month. We have achieved more than 95% coverage against the targets. However, the CSR funding received from SBI general could not be continued. We will continue this activity from general funding of Divyajyoti trust or will request for local support from Vyara and Kharel for this activity.

## TRUCK DRIVERS' SCREENING PROJECT

 We have started a project supported by Mission for Vision to screen truck drivers. Two camps were conducted during the month. We will screen 3000 truck drivers during the year. We are thankful to Mission for Vision for giving us this opportunity.



## EYE CAMP ACTIVITY

• We conducted field work with the help of optometry students to find out cataract patients from the service area of KAPS and performed 150 operations on these patients. Weekly two diagnostic eye camps have been continued.
