- (1) Hospital: 40 Bedded eye hospital since May 2011 providing comprehensive eye care to the society. All the facilities are provided free to the poor & needy people and at subsidised rate to others. Now, it's a fully equipped 100 bedded tertiary hospital (since Sept. 15).

Speciality work: All types of eye care treatment is available here. Consultant for Research, Cornea, Retina, Glaucoma as well as Paediatric ophthalmology & community ophthalmology are available daily. The consultant of occuloplasty, Neuro ophthalmology & cornea are visiting once or twice in a month on regular basis. We are one of the very well equipped hospitals in Gujarat with latest state of art equipments.

Training centre: From the beginning of the hospital, we have started training programmes for ophth. assistant, ophth. nurse, operation theatre technician, optical fitting etc. In addition, short term & long term training of Ophthalmologists in SICS; phaco emulsification, glaucoma, comprehensive ophthalmology & medical retina are also going on.

Research: We conduct epidemiological and clinical research on a regular basis. Presence of Dr. Rohan who is trained at ICEH is making it possible.

Networking – consultancy : Trust provides Technical assistance to nearby hospitals & evaluation activity for the hospital in different parts of India is being carried out. Trust works in close collaboration with NPCB, Vision 2020: Right to Sight India and INGOs.

(2) Outreach activity (field work):

Diagnostic Camp: Three diagnostic eye camps are conducted every week catering to a population of 2.5 million around, covering approx. 2000 villages.

Satellite centre: Netrang, Zankhvav community Health centre: Daily Eye OPD & twice a week operation activity at Netrang & Zankhvav is managed by Divyajyoti trust under public private partnership project with Govt. of Gujarat from April 2012 onwards.

Satellite centre: Chorvad Lions eye hospital: Ophth. Asstt.s trained by Divyajyoti Trust are managing OPD & camps regularly & visiting doctor thrice in a week performs surgery.

- (3) Community Based Rehabilitation programme: This programme has been started since Jan.15 for Mangrol & Umarpada Taluka of Surat district. Nearly 200 incurably blinds are identified to be rehabilitated now. We have completed this programme in Mandvi taluka last year Rehabilitated 115 blinds.
- (4) Integrated education programme: Blind children identified in the surrounding area are enrolled in regular schools in their villages and our braille teacher teaches them braille. Right now, there are about 14 such kids getting benefits of this activity.
- (5) Vivekananda Pragnachakshu Bhavan (Hostel for Blind children): Residential facility for blind children was created so that they get trained for hostel life & assure academic progress. This year 20 children are there in hostel & studying in local regular school. We teach them braille, computer and music additionally.

The Year at a glance 200

Last year, Divyajyoti Trust was honoured by 'XOVA award', a major mile stone in the history of the trust. As a part of Community Based Rehabilitation programme, the proposal - door to door screening for diabetes; blood pressure & IOP of 40+ individuals in Mangrol & Umarpada taluka was submitted to 'XOVA' – the CSR body of Novartis Pharma - accepted as innovative activity & XOVA award consisting of 20000 euro was conferred to Divyajyoti Trust in award ceremony held at Istanbul, Turky- Dr. Udaybhai accepted the award.

Divyajyoti Trust can now accept donation from abroad, as FCRA approval is received during the year. Similarly approval under income tax act 35 AC has also been received to accept donation for cataract corpus fund, now donors can avail 100 % Tax deduction against donation for Cataract corpus fund. We have joined hands with a US based organisation 'Wonder Work' involved in elimination of avoidable blindness; will help us for treatment of children & cataract surgery of adults. This is in addition to many such organisations like Vision Foundation of India, DBCS, Hari Om Sewa Trust, "Chhayando", Sargam group etc.

As we screen all 40+ individuals for diabetes, blood pressure and intra ocular pressure, free of cost among OPD Patients, we detect on an average, 10 new patients suffering from diabetes every month. This way, we will probably be able to prevent or delay Diabetic retinopathy & other serious side effects as treatment of diabetes is started. Thus by awareness creation, we are helping the society at large in our small way. Looking to above experience, we have started screening for diabetes, blood pressure & intra ocular pressure among 40+ patients in camps also. We have started selling white spectacles for a token amount of Rs. 30, designed to protect eyes from both sides. There was a good response from community as eyes are protected from injuries due to grain, leaves — branches or animals' horn / tail while working in farms. We hope that with this intervention, the cases of corneal ulcers will go down among these labour class people over a period of time.

As we have good infrastructure with latest technology; efficient & experienced O'logists & good no of patients, we have started training programme for ophthalmologists in "Phaco emulsification", "small Incision cataract surgery" & Medical, retina this year. 12 Ophthalmologists underwent different training. Long term fellowship in cornea is also started this year. During Nov. 14; Dr. Kulinbhai Kothari a well-known Ophthalmologist from Bombay city Eye Institute, Mumbai & his son Dr Saumilbhai visited Mandvi & gave live demonstration of complicated cataract surgery – the session was attended by doctors from Divyajyoti Trust; Rotary eye Institute Navsari; R.N.C free eye hospital Valsad and Sewa Rural Jhagadia. CME on basics in glaucoma was also organised the next day.

Corneal injury due to grain leaves; grass; insects etc. is high in this area & so is the need for cornea consultant. To satisfy the demand of such patients Dr. Rohanbhai Thakkar, surat visits hospital twice a month & Dr. Soniaben Kothari, Mumbai started coming once a month from Feb: 15. Both these doctors performed "Lamellar Karatoplasty" surgery in which one cornea is cut in two parts in such a way that each part can be used for each eye so that from one donated cornea, we can help two patients to get vision. This surgery is performed at few centres in Gujarat. We have achieved another milestone.

This year we have arranged speciality camps like diabetic retinopathy & paediatric camps in addition to regular diagnostic camps. Renovation work at Netrang is started by govt. as it is upgraded from P.H.C. to C.H.C. Hence, the surgical work was not possible there during the year. We tried to develop teleconsultation facility at Netrang & Jhankhvav BUT due to limitations of internet speed, we could not





establish the activity on strong footing.

During the year, various activities for capacity building of the staff was done. i.e. activities to strengthen team work; communication, vision – mission development, positive attitude & time management. Shri Falgunbhai Sheth (Shaishav, Bhavnagar) helped us in this activity.

A School Screening manual – prepared by Divyajyoti Trust was published by vision 2020 – Right to Sight India in July 14. This manual will be useful in school screening work through out the country. A diabetic retinopathy protocol has also been prepared under the leadership of Divyajyoti Trust on behalf of Vision 2020: Right to Sight India. Divyajyoti Trust arranged a meeting at Delhi with the generous help of Venu eye Institute & gathered well-known retina consultants from all over the country which is a matter of pride for us.

Our work is largely dependent on donations. This year donors came forward with innovative ideas on different occasions and provided donations. Shri Jivanbahi Rabari of Mandvi town arranged "Dayro" on the occasion of his grandson's marriage and donated the total amount received during "Dayaro" for blind children. Similarly Raghuvirsinh Thakore of Kosamba donated the money earmarked for traditional activity after death of his grandmother for a camp; Youth of the village donated their first salary or some amount on their birthday. It is heartening to note the philanthropy deep rooted among the youth.

Due to the rapid progress, present space started falling short in no time, we started new construction for five storeyed building after bhumipoojan on 30.3.14, completed in June'15. The new building has provision for eye bank, conference room, class room, dormitory, kitchen & administrative office. The top three floors are dedicated for 19 staff quarters & will be allotted to staff members including doctors, nursing staff, cook, driver & supporting staff. This building was planned to be a green building from beginning. So we adopted eco-friendly measures at each & every step. Divyajyoti Trust is registered with Indian Green Building Council (IGBC). An article is published regarding our eco friendly activity in Times of India, A' bad edition on 4/8/14 as well as in Divya bhaskar—Surat Mandvi edition.

A well-known diamond merchant - owner of Laxmi diamond, Shri Vasantbhai Gajera visited the hospital & distributed grocery kit to 1000 poor families of Mandvi Taluka.

Hospital as a Blessing for the poor

Mohanbhai Babarbhai Chaudhri aged 56 of vil. Vadesiya Tal. Mandvi, Dist: Surat, approached us on 8-7-13 to the hospital with a complaint of irritation in right eye since last 7-8 days.

Corneal ulcer was diagnosed here. So doctors gave him medicine & called him again. But somehow he didn't come back but went to Surat for second opinion. At Surat also some medicines were prescribed. Mohanbhai came back to Mandvi as there was no relief with the medicines prescribed from Surat. Now, he required corneal transplant to preserve integrity of the eye ball.

Corneal transplant was done with the help of cornea received from Surat. We could save the eye but vision could not be restored. Again on 18/8/14 we got good quality cornea and a repeat corneal transplant with cataract surgery was done. Now, Mohanbhai's sight is restored and is back to his daily routine. His family members are very happy. His son says that we got better treatment in Mandvi and not in a big city like Surat. Now, we will tell everybody to go to Mandvi for their eye problems to get correct & proper guidance."

As Tejas Eye hospital earned good reputation over 4 years of its existence in eye care; average daily OPD has reached 150 patients visits. This year, in December we examined 241 patients and on 16th Feb. 15, we examined 255 patients. In Dec. 14, we did maximum - 992 Surgeries. The average OPD increases on Monday & Thursday. As we started diabetic screening of 40+ patients in OPD free of cost, we send all 40+ OPD patients to laboratory directly after registration & others for refraction. This arrangement helped us to reduce waiting time of OPD patients.

We have started performing sutureless pterigyum surgery using glue during the year. To guide us in laboratory work up of corneal ulcer patients, Dr. Dineshbhai Khandhadia of Microaid laboratory, Ahmedabad & Dr. V. C. Poria, Surat visited us

To improve the quality & facility of operation theatre, we created 4th operation theatre for septic patients on first floor of the hospital. O.T. (2) had been renovated and air tight doors have been installed in all 4 operation theatres as well as laminar flow systems are installed to clean the circulating air in OT.

This year we have purchased New phaco machine (Alcon); Green Laser console (Aurolab); IOL master(Zeiss); Forus fundus camera; vision screener (welch Allyn); Autoclave machine; Rebound tonometers; tonopen; slit lamp; Automatic Blood pressure equipments; 27 seater van for school & diabetic retinopathy screening & offset printer to strengthen our infrastructure & facility to patients. For Zankhavav CHC we have purchased Inverter & vitrectomy machine.

The protocol to use all above equipments have been developed & we strictly ensure that protocol should be maintained so that quality of our service is maintained. To strengthen the capacity of ophthalmic assistants & nursing assistants, written test was taken during the year. Over & above, we organised different workshops also for them.

We appreciate sincere help of Dr Manishbhai Kagrecha; Dr Jayeshbhai Merchant & Shri Varsheshbhai Shah in training our nursing students. Additionally, Dr. Manishbhai for doing fitness of our poor patients. This huge work is possible with the help of such kind people.

Services of Retina consultant is available on full time basis but when she is absent during her training or leave — Dr. Bhavinbhai Patel & Dr. Khushboo Doctor have readily given their services to our retina patients. Dr. Heli shah and Dr. Saket Saradhiya also provided their services for medical retina during such period. We are thankful to all these doctor friends for their kind & generous help.

Govt. of India has recently permitted trained Ophthalmic assistants also to collect the eye donation and hence, our senior ophthalmic assistant Mr. Pradeep Patel and Mr. Yatin Mistry are doing the job after formal training. Now, Mr. Chirag Taiolr is learning the same.

Employees from Kakrapar Atomic Power Station regularly avail our services as we are empanelled with them for provision of eye care services to their employees.

We have installed costly optical fitting equipments to ensure that tailor made glasses are delivered within two hours – this saves second visit for our patients and thus the incidental cost. We hope to



provide tailormade glasses in two hours to majority of our patients.

Mr. Vinodbhai Dholakia is doing Internal Monitoring of day to day work & shri Arvindbhai Desai from Vaslad, visits regularly once in a month to help in monitoring work.

Two doctors left us – Dr. Archana Chaudhary got married and Dr. Chintan Dholakia completed his two years tenure. Dr. Jagruti Jariwala has joined us for two years and Dr. Upasana Patel has joined us for one year as comprehensive fellow.

Just like doctors, we are facing turnover among pharmacists also. Mrs. Khyati Mahida, Tarsada has joined us from March 2014 as pharmacist.




On examination at Mandvi, it was diagnosed that cornea was damaged & was called for follow up when Dr. Sonia Kothari from Mumbai would come. We procured good quality donor cornea from Hyderabad after Dr. Sonia examined Radhaben. Dr. Sonia performed lamellar keratoplasty during her next visit. Radhaben required a second surgery also. Now, her sight is restored in Right eye. Family members are very happy because Radhaben could see after almost 8-9 months. Radhaben & her family members are thankful to the hospital.

We wantd to provide comprehensive eye care to the community from beginning & so, we invited consultants from Surat, Mumbai, Vadodara & Ahmedabad to help our sub speciality work. Here is what we have achieved & statistics is given in the table below(2).

- 1. Retina Clinic: Dr. P.N.Nagpal well known Retina consultant examined all patients of diabetic retinopathy on first day of our hospital. Then, Dr. Madhviben Sheth from Baroda & Dr. Amishbhai Patel from Ahmedabad started to visit fortnightly and started treatment of Retina patients. As Dr. Khushboo joined from Jan. 12 on full time basis, retina work developed very fast. Vitrectomy machine donated by KAPS under their CSR project proved to be a boon for patients. There is no charitable organisation barring one or two hospitals to do free or subsidised treatment for retina patients, so patients not only form nearby area but from very far off places are approaching for retina treatment. Dr. Shilpa Patel takes care of retina work but patient load is beyond one person's capacity to handle.
- **2. Glaucoma Clinic**: Initially Dr. Meenaben Doshi from Mumbai used to visit once a month to take care of Glaucoma patients. It was observed that the patient load was high, so we sent Dr Sheetal for two months Glaucoma training to Pune & now she manages Glaucoma clinic.
- **3. Cornea Clinic :-** From Dr. Rohan's thesis, we knew that the corneal problems are more in this area. Initially Dr. Bijalben Mehta & Dr. Prakashbhai Nayak from Mumbai were taking care of these patients. After returning from London, Dr. Rohan Chariwala took care of cornea patients. He has done large no. of corneal transplants. Over & above, Dr. Rohan Thakkar Surat & Dr. Sonia Kothari, Mumbai are our visiting cornea consultants.

Corneal transplant is a job demanding special efforts & co-ordination. Not only that but when we have to collect corneas from Hyderabad or Navsari, it is costly also because transportation charge is high. We are doing more than 100 corneal transplant per year & this is among the top performances in the state.

- **4. Occuloplasty Clinic**: Dr. Bakulbhai Trivedi our trustee takes care of these patients from the beginning. Now, in addition, Dr. Saurin Gandhi Surat regularly visits once a month. An unusual occuloplasty operation for a case of neurofibromatosis on a young boy was performed by Dr. Saurin Gandhi. Dr. Parth Joshi is also performing these surgeries.
- **5. Paediatric Clinic :-** Dr. Nitin Jain coming once in a month takes care of paediatric patients since beginning. This year paediatric eye camp was organised & good no. of children benefitted. Helping these children save / restore sight is a life changing activity.
- **6. Neuro ophthalmology Clinic :-** Initially we did not have this facility. Dr. Tanuja Rakhe Surat initially started visiting once & now twice a month as work has increased.
- 7. Low vision clinic :- Dr. Rohan Chariwala manages low vision patients. We have necessary equipments.






Our challenges in rural areas

Chhaniben Naginbhai Rathod aged 52 is a native of village Tadkeshvar Tal. Mandvi, Dist. Surat. As she is widow and also blind due to cataract, stays with her daughter.

When she approached us in Karanj camp, was diagnosed bilateral cataract. Chhaniben was afraid of surgery so our staff counselled her for long, then she agreed. After surgeries, she got vision in both eyes so we sent her to home.

After 4-5 days, she developed inflammation in right eye and was advised hospitalisation. After getting admitted, next day she suddenly went home without informing us. Our staff went there & brought her again to the hospital & started the treatment. This time also she left the hospital without informing anybody. Again our staff brought her to the hospital. After long counselling, she agreed to take treatment. Now there is some relief in her right eye, left eye is o.k. Hence she can do her work independently.

Chhaniben's daughter appreciates our efforts & hard work very well. She says "really you are boon for the poor."

Consultancy & Evaluation

Divyajyoti trust in co-ordination with The Govt. of Guj. took the responsibility to develop operation theatre protocol. Dr. Uday participated in the workshops arranged by Govt of Guj. at Surat, Vadodara, Rajkot & Gandhinagar as a resource person in protocol workshops.

A diabetic retinopathy protocol has been prepared under the leadership of Divyajyoti Trust as a part of vision 2020 – right to sight India activity. We arranged a meeting at Delhi & gathered well known Retina consultants from all over the country & Dr. Rohan & Dr. Uday were resource persons for the workshop. Dr. Uday is a member of expert committee to develop Diabetic retinopathy protocol at National level.

Dr. Uday attended COSI meeting at Delhi, the Webinar on infection control organised by AIOS at Delhi, District planning workshop at Bhuvaneshwar for Sightsavers, infection control workshop at Jodhpur for JOS and Low vision guideline workshop for Vision 2020: Right to Sight India at H. V. Desai Eye Hospital pune as resource person.

This year, evaluation of Sitapur eye hospital – Sitapur, U.P.; Shroff's Charity Eye Hospital – Delhi's Mohamadi unit – Jehangirabad; Indira Gandhi Eye Hospital, Amethi was done by Dr. Uday as per request of sightsavers International. Mr. Pradip patel & Dr. Uday visited Tulsi eye hospital, Nashik for an evaluation exercise on behalf of mission for vision.

Research

Dr. Rohan chariwala presented scientific poster on "RAVI" survey at the Annual conference of American Academy of ophthalmology held at Chicago; USA in October 2014.

We have started door to door screening of 40+ individuals of Mangrol & Umarpada taluka for IOP; Blood pressure, Diabetes & Fundus photo with the help of XOVA's grant. This way, we will be able to inform the community about these dreaded diseases early and prevent major complications. CBR workers were trained to implement this project. This activity has been started from March 15.

Two e-posters & two scientific papers were presented at Delhi Ophthalmological Society conference - "willingness to pay for cataract surgery in tribal region of south Gujarat" & "Clinical profile of glaucoma patients in Tribal region of Surat district".

Graceful owner - the Indian tradition coming live

Prafulbhai of Vill. Vaghecha, Tal. Bardoli, Dist. Surat, is a tractor driver for a farm. One day he had an injury in his left eye while driving the tractor. Landlord Pareshbhai brought Prafulbhai to Tejas eye hospital immediately. There was corneal tear & had to be operated immediately. Parfulbhai was afraid of surgery, but his mentor Pareshbhai counseled him & then Prafulbhai agreed for surgery.

The Surgery was difficult as the injury was due to iron particle embedded very deep in the eye and magnet was required to remove it. We arranged for magnet from Surat and then surgery was done. Another surgery for retina was also required. After two complicated surgeries, Prafulabhai's eye was saved but the vision could not be restored. The expenditure was born by his mentor Shri Pareshbhai.

Prafulbhai & his family are very happy & thankful to Shri Pareshbhai & Tejas Eye hospital.





Outreach activity

Rural populace lacks the necessary transportation facility and the financial resources. Knowing this, we wanted to reach out to their doorsteps from the word go. Diagnostic eye camps is an established tool for the purpose. We are organising three diagnostic eye camps every week. This year, we successfully arranged 152 diagnostic eye camps and 25790 patients have been examined at the campsite. Total 3390 cataract surgeries are done.

This year from sept.14, we have started screening for diabetes, blood pressure, Glaucoma & retina as well at the campsite. If patient needs surgery, but is suffering from diabetes, we started bringing them with us to hospital on the same day - start medications to control sugar & pressure and then operate. Due to this, we could reduce dropout rate of patients.

Many donors prefer to work for children which is justifiable also, so we arranged 3 paediatric camps this year. Camps for diabetic retinopathy were also organised.

As we provide free transportation, accommodation, meal, medicines and surgery as well, the camps are very popular in surrounding area. We do get reimbursement on per surgery basis from DBCS for all the free surgeries done by us. It is a big support and we are thankful to the office bearers of DBCS for the same. Similarly vision foundation of India - Mumbai; Hari om seva trust - Vadodara; Sargam group — Surat; Maheshwari Samaj — Surat; Terapanth Samaj, Rajasthan Yuva sangh & "Drishti eye project" Scotland are our regular sponsors for camp. We sincerely appreciate their regular support.

Our camp activity has been evaluated by external agency -Mr Ghanshyam Pande from Gomabai netralaya visited camp site on $16 - 17^{th}$ April, met the patients randomly and suggested some changes to improve camp activity. We have implemented the same.

We arranged Asha workers' get to gather on 7/10/15 & announced to give Rs. 175 to them if they bring patient in camp and accompany them during his stay/surgery and transportation. However, we won't get any support from the Govt. for the same.

Similarly a get to gather of camp organisers was arranged on the occasion of 3rd annual day - 22nd may.


Netrang & Zankhvav

At Netrang & Zankhvav CHC we do ophthalmic work since April 2012. This year government authority decided to reconstruct the building of Netrang CHC, so we had shifted surgical work to Jhankhvav CHC. Due to turnover among staff at Jhankhvav, the work has not picked up as expected.

Looking to the need and importance of field work, Blind Foundation of India provided a Mobile van and equipments. We got 27 seater mobile van and installed a chair unit, fundus camera, indirect ophthalmoscope, slit lamp etc. We use it for school screening & door to door screening of diabetes in villages of our project area.

Last year, we helped restart Bhanuben Nanavati hospital at Chorwad, Dist. Junagadh. Work has started but is not picking up as expected, will look into what can be done in near future.

Community Based Rehabilitation (C.B.R.) 🙍 (

CBR Programme was implemented in Mandvi Taluka from April'12 to Dec.'14. Total population of 133 villages of Mandvi taluka was covered. Door to Door screening for Blindness & diabetes was carried out for 40+ individuals. Community support from Village Leaders, Asha & Anaganwadi workers, Sarpanch & Chairman of milk dairy was very good. Total 20000 random blood sugar & urine sugar tests were done & found 800 diabetics. Hardly 200 people were aware of that, School Screening programme for 196 schools of Mandvi Taluka was also conducted and vision testing for 15000 students was done. 116 students were referred to base hospital & 143 students received spectacles through DBCS. Total 1737 cataract surgeries were performed on patients from project area during the project period. 127 incurably blind persons were rehabilitated. We helped 90 blinds to get blindness certificate, 87 to get Bus pass & 123 blinds were trained for mobility. 6 boys & 5 girls were enrolled in regular schools in their village under integrated education programme. 42 blinds were trained in vocational activity. Four blind girls were sent to C.U. Shah Pragnachakshu Mahila Sevakunj - Surendranagar & 2 boys were sent to Tatawadi, Fansa for agricultural training. On completion of CBR Project, most of the field workers are absorbed at different posts in hospital itself. A 5 members team from Sewa Sadan Hospital, Bhopal had come to Mandvi for training in school screening activity. They were taken to Varjakhan - one of the projet villages & also to Bhoria primary school in Mangrol block for practical training. The Bhopal team enjoyed the training in field.

New CBR Programme in Mangrol & Umarpada taluka is started from January 15, total population of 3 lacs will be covered in this project. Door to door screening of blindness alongwith screening for diabetes, blood pressure & Intraocular pressure for 40+ people is planned. This project is considered as innovative idea & we got "XOVA" award for the same.

Vitamin 'A' is an important nutrient for eye health. But in some children — especially sugar cane labourers, children have deficiency of vitamin 'A', so we arranged to distribute vitamin 'A' & "Sukhadi" (nutricious sweet food item) to the children of sugarcane labourers with the help of our follow up worker in Mandvi block. Many times adolescent girls are not aware of what to do and how to maintain hygiene when they reach teens and menstruation cycles start. We started distributing sanitary kits to these girls along with health education messages with the help of our follow up worker.

World handicap day was celebrated in Mandvi on 3rd December. 78 handicapped persons were present. We informed them regarding different benefits to handicapped from govt. Also a kit containing grocery items was distributed during programme.

Economic Rehabilitation

During the year, we planned a meeting of blind beneficiaries in the age group of 18 to 50 to start some vocational activity. 25 blinds participated & 4 of them showed interest to start their own activity. We offered them interest free loan. 3 persons started their own small units & are now earning members of the family & returning the loan amount in instalments regularly. One person could not start any activity, so he returned the loan amount.

Hostel for Blind Children

There are 20 Blind Children residing at Vivekananda pragnachakshu Bhavan Mandvi. The aim to run hostel for blind children is to make them confident and self-reliant. To achieve this, we put continuous efforts. This year blind children prepared paper bag from newspaper waste, which is used to provide medicines from our medical store instead of plastic bag. During Diwali festival, blind children prepared candle light lamps & decorated them assisted by their mentor. Blind children participated in "Khel Mahakumbh " at Dsitrict level & won prizes of Rs. 42000/- This amount has been deposited in a/c of each child at Bank of Baroda, Mandvi. Among them, two children won first prize so they got chance to participate in state level competition.

Two workshops- one during summer vacation & another during diwali vacation were organised. Blind children from hostel as well as Mandvi, Ankleshwar, Zagadia & Dediyapada taluka participated and enjoyed the activity done during shibir. Picnic to Sayla — Chotila — Surendrangar, Picnic to kevadia colony & visit to Sewa Rural were organised during shibir.

The Mandvi district court – judge and lawyers of Mandvi donated cash amount for blind children & police commissioner, Surat distributed braille kit to blind children. Surat Maheshwari samaj invited all the blind children to celebrate Hanuman Jayanti at Surat & donated daizy player (like an I pod with recording facility) – to store books in audio format for blinds to listen and study.

Children learn music every Sunday & now can sing according to "Raga". All children will appear in 2nd exam for music. Shri Ashokbhai Chaudhary - music teacher gives his services free of cost for these children. The owner of the house where children resides – Mr. Snehalbhai shah allowed us to use his property free of cost. We are thankful to them.

Vision 2020: Right to Sight Gujarat Chapter

Dr. Uday is heading the responsibility of Vision 2020: Right to Sight Gujarat Chapter. We organised two programmes during the year. One glaucoma workshop on 4.5.14 in Surat and invited Dr. Devindra Sood, Delhi and Dr. Mayuriben Khamar, Ahmedabad – both renowned experts. More than 50 delegates attended the same. Another workshop on "Counselling" at Polio Foundation, Ahmedabad on 15.3.15 was attended by nearly 100 cousnellors from across the state.



Peterkui & Pipalvan

Surat Manav Seva Sangh "Chhanydo" took responsibility for overall development of two villages - Peterkui & Pipalvan. Initially Chhanydo provided handpumps or repaired them if required to create facility of drinking water. Repaired check dams to provide water supply to farms. They offered interest free loan to students & enterpreneurs. Distributed grocery kit during Diwali festivals. Chhanydo built a temple in both villages so that people can do spiritual activity and improve their quality of life.

In our society, marriage ceremony is an expensive affair. To avoid individual expenditure "Samuh lagna" (group marriage) is a better option. So Chhanydo conducted samuh lagna at these villages and donated domestic goods to the newly wed couples.

Braille teacher from Divyajyoti trust conducts tutorial classes (extra coaching) regularly in these villages. The basic learning process of children is improving. All these efforts by Chhanydo is for overall – economic, social, educational and spiritual upliftment of these villages.

Awareness Activity

During the year, we put no. of efforts for awareness about eye care & eye donation. Every Saturday our staff goes to nearby villages; shows video on the subject and by question – answer session, they try to give health education. In the hospital, our ophthalmic assistants give instruction for Pre and post operative care on daily basis in the evening using a video. We have prepared one 10 min. video demonstrating post op care; medication, food and hygiene. Similarly a school screening video is also prepared upon request and financial assistance from combat blindness foundation.

One rally was organised during eye donation fortnight this year - students of V.F. High School, Mandvi participated with posters on eye donation. World sight day was celebrated by performing role plays on Glaucoma and diabetic retinopathy in - Areth, kadod & Madhi on 9th, 10th & 11th October at night and the next day, eye check-up was carried out in the same villages. Similarly, on world diabetes day on 14th November, same role plays were performed. Thus we are continuously trying for raising the awareness of the community by means of video; Role-play & pamphlets.

One pamphlet on community based rehabilitation (CBR) has been prepared this year as well as calendar for two years showing details of CBR activity, Govt. benefits to the blind as well as handicaps & rehabilitation activity done in Mandvi Taluka.

Award and felicitation

CSR body of Novartis pharma co. – XOVA gives award to innovative activity in Eye Health care every year. We are one of the five recipients of this award globally this year. This award is given to Divyajyoti Trust for innovative project titled "Door to Door Screening for glaucoma, diabetes & hypertension incorporated in to a pre-existing CBR programme in Umarpada and Mangrol Taluka". Dr. Udaybhai had

gone to Istanbul, Turky to receive this award.


All the activities done by Divyajyoti trust are dependent on donations as almost 70% of the work is being done totally free and rest of it on a heavily subsidised basis.


Last year, the trust has spent Rs. 5.8 crores on hospital, diagnostic eye camps, training and research activities, Community Based Rehabilitation programme and staff welfare. Of this, Rs. 3.29 crore was recurring expense. Among non recurring expenses – Rs. 1.69 crore is spent on new construction, Rs. 70 lacs has been spent on purchase of equipments and Rs. 11.75 lacs were spent on purchase of mobile van.

Various sponsors for diagnostic eye camps including Vision Foundation for India, Hari Om Sewa Trust, Wonderwork, Maheshwari Samaj and Sargam builders are regularly supporting the work financially. In addition, District Blindness Control Society and Rashtriya Swasthya Bima Yojana (RSBY) are also supporting the work partially. Tribal sub plan, Mandvi is supporting routine camps and Diabetic retinopathy screening camps regularly. Kitchen is run with financial support from Surat Manav Seva Sangh "Chhanyado" where we provide food to our patients & relatives, OPD patients at token charge & blind children of hostel.

Direct patient income including OPD & indoor was 16% of the total income (Rs. 90 lacs). The turnover in Janseva optical & medical shops was 8% (Rs. 46 lacs). Thus, it is obvious that the huge shortfall has to be covered through generous donations from individuals & organisations. Major support is received from Surat Manay Seva Sangh "Chhanyado", Lilavati R. Shah Medical Relief Trust- Mumbai, Vision Foundation of India - Mumbai, Combat Blindness Foundation-USA, Taraben Naranbhai Patel trust- Ahmedabad, Pentagon Cheritable trust-Mumbai, ONGC- Hazira plant and other philanthropic organisations.

Now, that we are registered under FCRA, we will be able to accept donations from abroad also. Similarly, we will be able to accept corpus donations for cataract operations under 35 AC where in the donor will get 100% tax exemption. We are sure that generous support from people like you and many others will continue in future also for this noble activity.


