PUBLICATION

- A case report prepared by Dr. Suhal Shah on our blind girl Pratiksha related to the need for psychological support to mentally traumatised kids is published in Indian Journal of Mental Health. It depicts very well the need for counselling and support to such kids.

TRUCK DRIVERS' SCREENING PROJECT

- 3 camps were conducted during the month. By now, we have screened 347 truck drivers and cleaners in 3 camps.

ROP PROJECT

- We have screened 54 babies and treated 4 babies during the month.

CBR PROJECT FOR SONGADH TALUKA

- By the end of the month, we have screened more than 5892 individuals and covered a population of 25873. Close to 297 cataract operations have already been performed. We have recruited additional workers and now, we have 16 workers - two in each cluster.
