NETRAJYOTI TRAINING CENTRE

- Training of three batches of vision assistant students and internship of one batch of students is going on well. Their
 performance in weekly exams is improving. They are learning practical skills also very well. Majority of the students who are
 doing internship right now, have agreed to work at the respective vision centre where they are posted right now. With these
 students joining us, most of our vision centres will have two staff members.
- Training of new batch of optometry students is also going on well. Internship of third batch of optometry students is also going on well. Exam was taken in the last week of the month for all the four batches. Fourth year students will complete their internship by mid-August and join Lenskart. The third year students will start their internship from middle of July or so.



- Our first and second year optometry students and three batches of vision assistant students were sent to Uka Tarsadia University from 12th to 16th June for a crash course in soft skills development. We thank the centre for humanities department for the same.
- Dr. Mansi Karia our Glaucoma consultant has gone to Tirunelveli Aravind Eye Hospital for advanced Glaucoma Management training for two weeks in the second half of June.
- Two days CME on 3rd and 4th June was organised for our Ophthalmic Assistant cadre. As usual, we had invited Mr. Debashis Maiti from Mission for Vision for the same. He provided very useful practical training to the staff. Now, it is their turn to implement the same.

A pre close out visit for Ranibizumab study was carried out during the month as we are not able to find suitable patients. Enrolment in Toric IOL study of Omni ltd. is going on. We hope to finish the enrolement in a month or two.
