DIAGNOSTIC EYE CAMPS

- We have continued door to door screening in Mangrol taluka. During the month, we have screened 10184 individuals and distributed 942 readymade spectacles and 243 tailor-made spectacles.

ROP PROJECT

- We have screened 144 babies and treated 1 baby during the month.

RESEARCH PROJECT:

- We have continued enrolment of patients in Eyecryl 600 plus IOL study and Eyecryl ASHFY 600 IOL study of Biotech. By the end of April, we have enrolled 160 and 163 patients respectively. Due to reduced workload, the enrolment was very slow during the month.
- Ms. Suchal Shivani underwent online training on "EDC" in connection with the ongoing clinical trials of a biotech company during this month. The training enhanced her understanding of electronic data capture systems and clinical trial documentation processes.

GENERAL

- Umapada comprehensive screening project implementation started from September 2024. Door to door screening was completed in July 2025. Follow up activity was started for all those who were referred but have not yet availed services. We have screened 83044 Individuals in total. 1 Camp was organised and 96 individuals were examined and 17 cataract surgeries have been performed including patients referred from vision centres and walk in patients coming to the base hospital. A mop up round was carried out with the help of our Vision assistant and Optometry college students. We have reached out to all the 20000+ individuals with 40+ age and distributed 1992 spectacles. An impact assessment study is also started with the help of Dr. B. R. Shamanna and his team.
- Ms. Krishna Patel from Canada - a management expert has started online training of our supervisors to bring about improvement in the output. She is taking one hour class every week. We sincerely appreciate her kind gesture of helping us from a distance.
- We lost our trustee and secretary Shri Nalinbhai Shah on 30.4.26. It will be big loss. We pray Almighty to grant eternal peace to the departed soul.
- A Fire safety Mock Drill Training Session was conducted by the KAPS team during this month. The session provided valuable guidance on fire safety measures, emergency response, and evacuation procedures, helping staff enhance their preparedness and safety awareness.
- We procured a new ambulance under the CSR support of LIC HFL during this month. This addition strengthened our emergency and outreach services, enabling us to provide timely and improved healthcare support to the community.
- To improve communication with patients, Mrs. Madhaviben Gajiwala started soft skills classes for our front desk management staff during this month. The sessions focused on enhancing communication, patient interaction, and professional service standards.
- Mrs. Minaxiben Desai and Shri Rajeshbhai Desai - donor from Sudama Charitable trust, UK visited us on 7th April. Mr. S. K. Malaviya, site director of KAPS visited us on 11th April.
