Hospital

- We have performed 1643 surgeries during this month which is slightly less than what we did in February last year -1697. We staggered the inflow of patients and ensured that the numbers were within our reach.
- On 28th February - Saturday, we performed 17 DCR surgeries on one day. The waiting list for DCR had grown too much and our visiting Oculoplasty consultant Dr. Shalinbhai gracefully agreed to spare one more day. This is the highest number of DCR surgeries on one day in the history of Divyajyoti trust.
- Dr. Uma Shroff was awarded FAICO Paediatric Ophthalmology certificate at Delhi during AIOS Education day celebration on first February.
- Dr. Sonia Goel has joined us from 9th February as a full time Cornea Consultant.

VISION CENTRES

- We have continued bimonthly visit of a team consisting of Ophthalmologist, Ophthalmic assistant, maintenance staff and cleaning staff to vision centres. During this month, our team has visited Umarpada, Kim, Selamba and Vyara centres.
- Two community meetings were conducted during the month. One at Dediapada vision centre as an orientation meeting for the Agricultural college students where 40 students participated. The other meeting was held at Uchchal vision centre's Jamtalao village where 85 individuals including Sarpanch, leaders and well-wishers attended the meeting.

DIAGNOSTIC EYE CAMPS

- We have continued door to door screening in Mangrol taluka. During the month, we have screened 15356 individuals and distributed 968 readymade spectacles and 113 tailor-made spectacles.

CBR PROJECT FOR SONGADH TALUKA

- Last set of 24 blinds are taken up for rehabilitation work from November. Alongside, follow up of curable blinds identified during the survey is also going on. We have continued conducting weekly diagnostic eye camps in the project area. 8 Camps were organised during the month. 719 patients were examined and 97 surgeries have been carried out.

SCHOOL SCREENING:

- We have continued school screening in Sagbara taluka and later shifted to Mandvi taluka. During this month, we have screened 2814 children. Refraction was done for 68 children and 30 have been provided spectacles free of cost. 38 students have been referred to the base hospital.

VIVEKANAND PRAGNACHAKSHU BHAVAN:

- Schools had reopened in June. There are eight students in the hostel right now. Kids have settled well.

ROP PROJECT

- We have screened 105 babies and treated 1 baby during the month.

RESEARCH PROJECT:

- Enrolment in Biotech Eyecryl Toric IOL study is completed now. We have continued enrolment of patients in Eyecryl 600 plus IOL study and Eyecryl ASHFY 600 IOL study of Biotech last month. By the end of February, we have enrolled 140 and 131 patients respectively. Enrolment of patients was started for Omni EDOF IOL study. Enrolment in Omni EDOF IOL study is completed during the month with 56 patients.

GENERAL

- Umapada comprehensive screening project implementation started from September 2024. Door to door screening was completed in July 25. Follow up activity was started for all those who were referred but have not yet availed services. We have screened 83044 Individuals in total. 6 Camps were organised and 284 individuals were examined and 53 cataract surgeries and 4 other surgeries have been performed including patients referred from vision centres and walk in patients coming to the base hospital. Due to winter season, the response of patients is better.
- Kakrapar CSR Team had signed an MOU for cataract operations. By the end of February, all the operations have been completed. Final report will be submitted soon. Their CSR team visited one of the camps and they visited hospital also to meet patients.
- Mr. Yash Jain from LIC HFL visited us on 16.2.26 as a part of their due diligence process. They have approved one ambulance under their CSR head.
- Ms. Sarah Jameel from PRASHO, Hyderabad visited us on 25-26 February to look at the pilot data collection going on for the ORCB project. She was happy with the progress and has given us a few suggestions.
- GCP training of our research team was conducted virtually on 28th February by Dr. Ashish Rastogi from CT Quest. 22 members joined the training.
- Divyajyoti Trust's journey published in print media in Gujarat Mitra on 3rd Feb. 2026.
- Mr Bharatbhai Patel (USA) our donor for Camp has visited our campus on 26th Feb. 2026.
