DIAGNOSTIC EYE CAMPS

- We have continued door to door screening in Vyara taluka. During the month, we have screened 12055 individuals and distributed 525 readymade spectacles and 120 tailor-made spectacles.

SCHOOL SCREENING

- We have continued school screening in Mandvi taluka. During this month, we have screened 1020 children. Refraction was done for 35 children and 19 have been provided spectacles free of cost. 16 students have been referred to the base hospital.

TRUCK DRIVERS' EYE SCREENING:

- From 1st June, we have started screening of truck drivers with financial support of Reliance Industries in Hazira area. During the month, we have screened 620 truck drivers, provided ready spectacles to 279 and tailor-made glasses to 50 individuals. In addition, 18 were referred to base hospital for detailed examination / surgery.

VIVEKANAND PRAGNACHAKSHU BHAVAN

- Schools have opened in June. There are only 5 students in the hostel right now. 6-8 more students are expected to come but some renovation in the hostel is going on and the students will be called after completion of the renovation work.

ROP PROJECT

- We have screened 143 babies and treated 0 baby during the month.

RESEARCH PROJECT:

- We have continued enrolment of patients in Eyecryl 600 plus IOL study and Eyecryl ASHFY 600 IOL study of Biotech. By the end of July, we have enrolled 201 and 209 patients respectively. Due to reduced workload, the enrolment was very slow during the month.
- Data collection for ORCB is continued. After a review of the data collected and revisiting the basic objective, the data collection format has been revised.
- Our ethics committee meeting was conducted online on 23rd July. One study from Omni Marketing Ltd. for Trifocal IOL and one study from Biotech on safety and efficacy of Fluorescein strips were cleared. Three more studies submitted by our visiting Oculoplasty surgeon Dr. Shalin Shah on - normalisation of conjunctival flora after endonasal DCR, three different modalities of treatment of OSSN and levator surgery for Ptosis were also cleared. Two case reports submitted by Dr. Uma were cleared as exempted from clearance.
- Ms. Priya Suman, on behalf of Eccentric Clinical Research, conducted a Site Qualification Visit (SQV) at Divyajyoti Trust for an upcoming Phase III, Multicenter, Randomized, Double-Blind, Double-Dummy, Active-Controlled, Parallel-Group Glaucoma Study. The visit assessed the site's infrastructure, research capabilities, and readiness to participate in this multicenter clinical trial.

GENERAL

- A team working on artificial intelligence to improve medicine adherence by sending reminders was invited to the hospital in June. MARS has been implemented on pilot basis for 100 cases. It is showing promising results.
- On 3rd July, Doctors' day was celebrated by felicitating all our doctors.
- The branding work for the LIC HFL Sanjeevani Ambulance has been successfully completed. This is supported by LIC HFL under CSR.
- Mr. Tarlok Singh joined Divyajyoti Trust on 26 July 2026 to strengthen the organization's financial systems and processes. With over 15 years of experience in finance, operations, and strategic leadership, his expertise is expected to enhance financial governance, streamline operational efficiency, and support the Trust's long-term sustainability and growth.
