- Training of optometry students is going on well. New batch of first year students have joined the college. Regular sessions are started. Final year students have joined internship.
- New batch of Vision assistant students had joined from 1st August. Theory classes are going on regularly. Their skills are improving quickly. Students are genuinely doing very good work.
- Glaucoma poster competition of Optometry students was organised with the financial support of Insight pharma in the context of world glaucoma week celebration. SCHOOL SCREENING:

- We have continued school screening in Mandvi taluka. During this month, we have screened 1217 children. Refraction was done for 31 children and 8 have been provided spectacles free of cost. 23 students have been referred to the base hospital.

CONSULTANCY

- Dr. Uday went to Jabalpur on 23rd to conduct a clinical audit of one hospital there at the suggestion of Sightsavers.

CBR PROJECT FOR SONGADH TALUKA

- Last set of 24 blinds was taken up for rehabilitation work from November. By the end of the month, this project is completed. Alongside, follow up of curable blinds identified during the survey was also going on. We had continued conducting weekly diagnostic eye camps in the project area. 7 Camps were organised during the month. 464 patients were examined and 48 surgeries have been carried out.

VIVEKANAND PRAGNACHAKSHU BHAVAN:

- Schools had reopened in June. There are eight students in the hostel right now. Kids have settled well.

DIAGNOSTIC EYE CAMPS

- We have continued door to door screening in Mangrol taluka. During the month, we have screened 16259 individuals and distributed 962 readymade spectacles and 109 tailor-made spectacles.

ROP PROJECT

- We have screened 124 babies and treated 4 babies during the month.

RESEARCH PROJECT:

- We have continued enrolment of patients in Eyecryl 600 plus IOL study and Eyecryl ASHFY 600 IOL study of Biotech. By the end of March, we have enrolled 158 and 154 patients respectively.

GENERAL

- Umarpada comprehensive screening project implementation started from September 2024. Door to door screening was completed in July 25. Follow up activity was started for all those who were referred but have not yet availed services. We have screened 83044 Individuals in total. 2 Camps were organised and 110 individuals were examined and 2 cataract surgeries have been performed including patients referred from vision centres and walk in patients coming to the base hospital.
- Earlier during the month, we received our Clinical establishment act registration valid for a five years period. Towards the end of the month, we have received 12A and 80G registration valid for 5 years. Thanks to the authority.
- A get-together of well-wishers of our outreach activities was organised on 15th March. Shri Nimeshbhai Shah, president Mandvi Municipal Corporation and Dr. Wankhede from Kakrapar were the chief guest and guest of honour respectively. 72 well-wishers attended the meeting. Everybody praised the new infra-structure created at Amalsadi. On behalf of Divyajyoti trust, we appreciated the generous support received from well-wishers for the outreach activities and requested them to continue the support in future also.
- On 29th, a handover function for the equipments received under Global grant with Rotary club of Surat Roundtown was organised. District Governor from district 3060 Mr. Amardeep Singh and PDG Shri Tusharbhai Shah along with club president Shri Kaurinbhai Panwala presided over the function. Dr. Uday gave detailed information about the association with Rotary club of Surat Roundtown over 15 years. Shri Bharatbhai praised the club for their huge support. Both DG and PDG appreciated the good work done by Divyajyoti trust.
- We have procured new fully automatic edging machine for fitting of spectacles. It has definitely improved the finishing and saves good bit of time also for the staff.
- Ms. Krishna Patel from Canada - a management expert has started online training of our supervisors to bring about improvement in the output. She is taking one hour class every week. We sincerely appreciate her kind gesture of helping us from a distance.
- International women's day was celebrated with a lot of enthusiasm by all the female staff members. They played games and then watched Gujarati movie "Umbro". On Sunday 8th, Wen Lido - self-defence training of all women staff and students was organised with the help of team from Shaishav. All female staff learnt useful tricks. Our sincere heartfelt thanks to Shaishav team.
- Mr. S. K. Malaviya - Site director KAPS, Mr. Sahoo - CSR Head KAPS and Mr. Nimeshbhai Shah - President Mandvi municipal corporation visited the hospital and praised the infra-structure.
