- Ranjan Parmar and Bhumit Rathod completed their 3 months training in counselling at H. V. Desai Eye Hospital, Pune by the end of the month.
- Dr. Uday Gajiwala spoke about post operative infections in Ophthalmology and statutory requirements in the DISC OS certificate online course organised by AIOS on 17th Sept. This is a series of 10 webinars organised by the AIOS and Adverse events reporting committee (Dr. Uday is the chairman of the committee).

VISION CENTRES

- We have continued bi monthly visit of a team consisting of Ophthalmologist, Ophthalmic assistant, maintenance staff and cleaning staff to vision centres.
- One community meeting was held during the month at Vadi in relation to Jhankhvav centre 40 individuals attended the same.

Diagnostic eye camps:

- Similarly, we have started door to door screening and adhoc eye camp activity in Netrang taluka also. During the month, we have screened 2788 individuals and distributed 1368 readymade spectacles and 174 tailormade spectacles.

Truck drivers' screening camps:

- At the suggestion of Gujarat Chemical Port Ltd., we have started screening of truck drivers and cleaners in Dahej area. We screened 1331 truck drivers and provided spectacles to 718 truck drivers during the month. Due to continuous rains, the numbers are less than expected but we hope that situation will improve once the raining stops.

CBR PROJECT FOR SONGADH TALUKA

- Actual implementation of CBR project - training of incurably blind individuals is started after the completion of second module training of the workers. We have taken 24 blinds for rehabilitation during this quarter.

ROP PROJECT

- We have screened 113 babies and treated 2 babies during the month.

GENERAL

- Our team visited Japan during this month. This was a major milestone for us. The team observed the training, research and Ophthalmic clinic activities over there. They could visit the HQ of Topcon company also. They visited PANASONIC HQ also.
- MFV team with the CSR head of IQVIA visited us during the month in relation to sponsoring 10 vision assistant students. She was happy to see the training activity and most likely, they will sponsor 10 students this year.
- ROP project for Navsari, Surat and Tapi districts is approved by MFV during the month. We are very thankful to them for this help.
- Eyecreel 600 IOL study of Biotech is ongoing. Total 413 enrolments have already been done including 180 patients bilateral enrolment.
- Umarpada comprehensive screening project implementation started during the month. As it is beginning of the project, all the workers have moved around in one group. Approx. 2000 individuals were examined during the month.
- Construction work is now progressing towards completion. Due to heavy rains, we are not in a position to complete the work before inauguration and so, we have decided to go ahead with the inauguration but shifting will get delayed by a couple of months.
